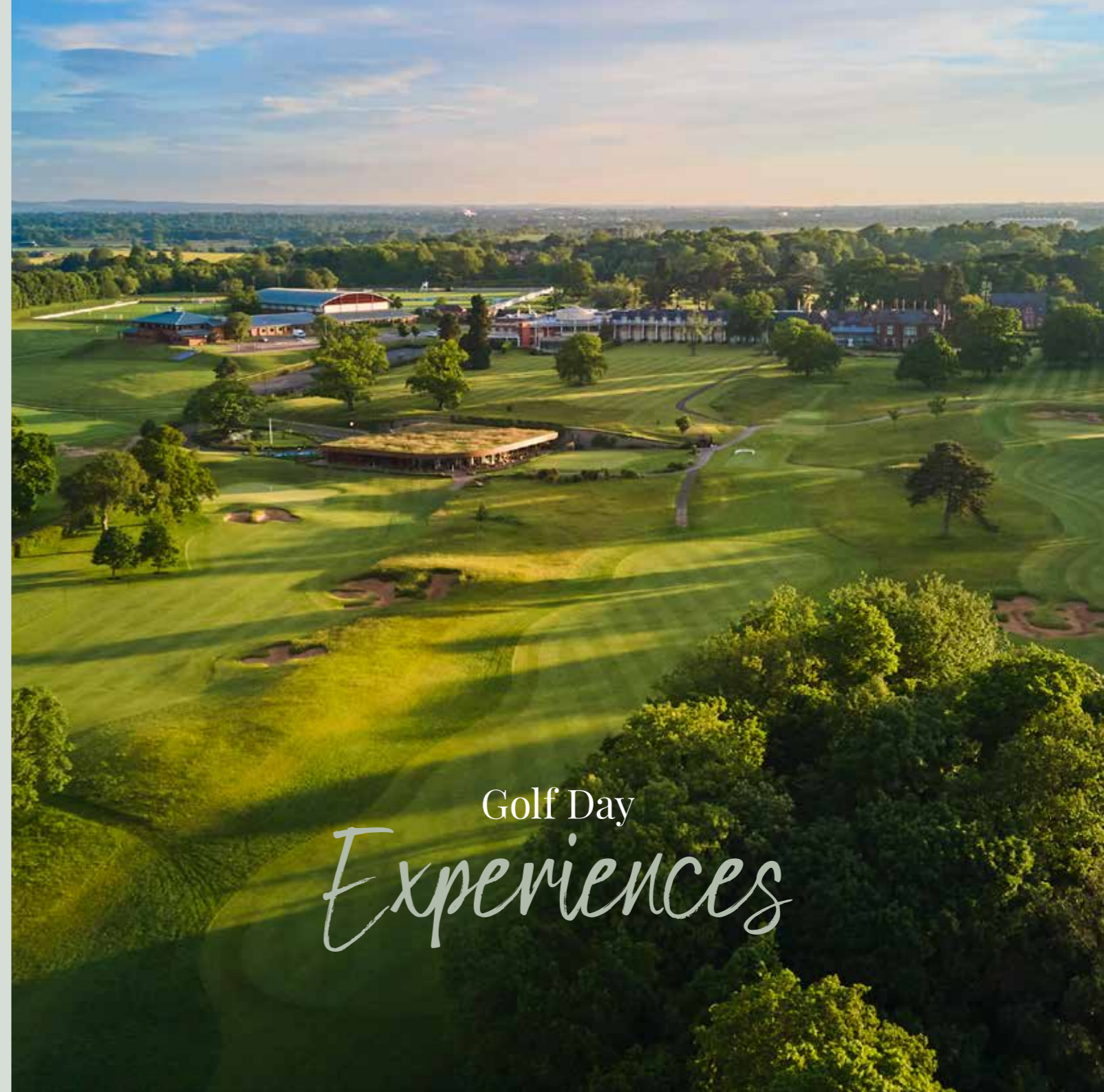

Rules & Etiquette

HANDICAP AND STANDARD OF PLAY

Evidence of handicap certificate is not mandatory however the minimum requirement for all golfer's handicap is recommended to be no worse than 28 for men and 36 for ladies. Our golf course marshals shall monitor the pace of play on the day.

ETIQUETTE

Visitors are expected to consider other players, safety on the course and pace of play. We would ask all golfers to rake bunkers, repair all pitch markers and replace divots.

DRESS CODE

Rockliffe Hall prides itself on its relaxed and friendly atmosphere, and even though we have a comfortable approach within the clubhouse, a standard dress codes applies on the course.

On the course we do not permit denim, combat trousers, non-golf apparel shirts and untailored shorts. Golf shoes with soft spikes are allowed only, we can change metal spikes on the day of the event for a small fee.

BUGGY AND TROLLEY POLICY

Buggies, hire trollies and winter trolley wheels are all subject to availability dependant on course conditions and weather.

Buggies must be kept to fairways and paths where possible, and golfers are not permitted to drive in the long rough.

Rockliffe Hall reserves the right to withdraw any hire equipment that is misused by any golf visitor and remove a guest from the premises if cause for concern.
