### Rockliffe Summer Blend

## Black Tea

### Assam Bargang

The leaves are broken with tippy heads, which helps to give it a strong and creamy infusion, which is perfect for those looking for a more powerful Assam brew and ideally drunk with a little milk.

### Ceylon Decaffeinated
