

The Golf Club Rules at Rockliffe Hall

Members and Member guests, must at all times comply with the Golf Club Rules at Rockliffe Hall and the R & A Rules of Golf which can be found at <https://www.theukrules.co.uk/rules/sport/golf/Official-Rules-of-Golf.pdf> from time to time and any and all other rules and regulations stipulated by Rockliffe Hall and/or the Royal & Ancient Golf Society from time to time;

Membership Details

- Members must inform Rockliffe Hall in writing (which shall include email) of any changes to the personal details provided in the Membership Application Form. Rockliffe Hall shall have the right to suspend your Membership until verified contact details are provided.

Induction

- All Members must attend an induction to the Golf Club at a new member's meeting when invited by Rockliffe Hall to attend.

Opening Hours

- The Golf Course will be open for play from 8am in the summer months and from 9am in the winter months subject to weather and ground conditions. The Clubhouse will be open half an hour before the first tee off time through to 11pm. Rockliffe Hall may, at its discretion, vary the opening hours of The Clubhouse in response to business patterns and private bookings and events. Any changes will be posted on the Clubhouse notice boards.

Entry Points

- Members must use the designated entry points only at the Golf Club and Golf Course and make themselves aware of the emergency exit and meeting points and procedures.

Playing

- Membership entitles the Member to play golf at all permitted times subject to booking a tee off time which can be done up to ten (10) days in advance, subject to availability; and to use of the Club House, when open to Members, and the option to enter all Rockliffe Hall Golf competitions for which they are eligible.
- Members may be required to pre-book guests at busy periods including weekends, bank holidays and school holidays.
- Buggies and electrical and pull trollies are permitted subject to assessment of ground conditions from time to time by Rockliffe Hall. In the event that it is not deemed safe to use buggies and/or trollies Members will be notified via the notice boards in the Club House. Any breach of such notice will be deemed a breach of this Contract.

- The Golf Course is a four ball course. Rockcliffe Hall reserves the right to make games up to a four ball at busy times.
- to check in at the Golf Club Reception before play. Members are advised to arrive at least ten (10) minutes prior to their tee off time. Whilst every effort will be made to accommodate late arrivals, no guarantee is made that the Member will be able to gain access subject to course availability.
- The rules of the game of golf are adapted from time to time by The Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews where RHL shall apply and etiquette for both the course and The Clubhouse shall be displayed on The Club House noticeboard for adherence to by all Members and guests.

Health & Safety

- Fire exits are clearly marked in the Club House. If you hear a fire alarm or see a fire you must make your way to the nearest assembly point.
- If you suffer an accident or injury you must inform a Team Member immediately.
- You must not smoke on the Golf Course or in the Club House.
- You should not attend the Club House or Golf Course if you have an infectious illness or condition.
- It is the Member's responsibility to ensure that they are fit to play and that they wear suitable attire for the conditions of play.

Photographs and videos

- Members may take photographs and videos for their personal use provided that you keep to these rules and any extra rules displayed on the notice boards in the Club House from time to time.
- Members must not take photographs or videos of children under 18 years, other than their own children.
- Anyone who appears in your photographs or videos must be aware that you are filming them and you must have their permission.
- You must not take photographs or videos in a changing area or toilet.
- If another member or guest is not happy that you are filming them and makes a complaint to Rockcliffe Hall, you will be required to cease filming and may be

requested by Rockliffe Hall or the member or guest to show the images and/or video footage and to delete them if appropriate.

- If a Team Member asks you to stop filming or taking photographs you must do so immediately.

Dogs

- With the exception of working assistance dogs, Members are not permitted to bring pets onto the Golf Course or into the Club House.

Feedback

- There is a process in place for Member feedback which can be accessed via the Pro Shop in the Club House. Derogatory or defamatory comments about Rockliffe Hall Team Members or other members and guests will not be tolerated and may lead to Membership suspension or cancellation.
